Objectives of the project

The Association des grands-parents du Québec (AGPQ) is a family rights organization. This community-based organization advocates on behalf of grandchildren so that they can maintain a quality relationship with their grandparents and extended family, and learn about their family origins. She is equally committed to defending the rights of seniors who are victims of abuse and exploitation of their loved ones.

Action Plan against Elder Abuse

In the fall, with community partners, we will launch a pilot project to counter elder abuse. This project will cover the Beauport Borough. A project manager will be hired in the coming days. To achieve this, the Association received a grant of \$25,000 from Canadian Heritage and \$1500 from the Regroupement des organismes sociaux communautaires de Beauport. Over the past four years, the AGPQ has often found that grandchildren are used to abuse seniors. Words like these have been reported to us several times: "If you don't give me \$\$\$ x, you won't see the little ones anymore".

Adoption and grandparents

In 2006, we said: "Our most important issue in the coming year will be the review of the Youth Protection Act. Many grandparents risk losing their right to see their grandchildren if the government responds to DYPs' requests for early adoptions of children whose parents are experiencing difficulties. In the event of adoption, biological grandparents no longer have any rights. Since Bill 125 is now in force, this issue is even more topical. That is why the AGPQ has intervened in several

ways to advance our demands so that grandparents retain their rights, even in the event of adoption: press releases, participation in a conference, letter to the Minister of Justice, meeting with its political attaché, Me Christian Veillette, collaboration with partner organizations such as the COFAQ and the Mouvement retrouvailles.

According to some of our sources, a bill revising Quebec's adoption regime could be introduced this year. In any case, the AGPQ will continue its fight on this issue. A brief will be submitted if necessary.

Network of lawyers and psychologists

The AGPQ has established a network of partners (lawyers, psychologists and mediators) in the various regions of Quebec. It is worth noting Luc Trudeau's extraordinary collaboration in the Greater Montreal Area, but also in the regions. His expertise and competence in defending grandparents are assets for them and for their Association. He comes to meet the grandparents at our monthly meetings in Montreal. He also travelled to Quebec City and Trois-Rivières for some meetings. He has represented us in several interviews on behalf of the AGPQ. Thank you, Mr. Trudeau.

Help line

We are particularly proud of our toll-free 1-866-745-6110 line available to grandparents in difficulty throughout Quebec. It is open seven days a week, 72 hours of availability. We counted nearly 40,000 minutes of listening to grandparents in difficulty during the year.

For their dedication in listening to grandparents, I would like to thank Monic Avoine, Gisèle Bergeron, Micheline Drouin and Danielle Piquette.

Training of listeners

Last year, the AGPQ received a grant of \$23,343 to have professionals train listening volunteers. For example, a training plan for listeners was developed in the form of a PowerPoint presentation and a training document. Both tools have been translated into English, as well as our brochure and website. The AGPQ now has the necessary tools to train its volunteers. This allows us to properly recruit and train new volunteers.

Thanks to the collaboration of a psychologist, Mr. Richard Langevin, and a lawyer, Mr. Luc Trudeau, a training video (DVD) for listening to grandparents was produced. Thank you for the dedication of these two people and to Mr. Yves Lajoie, Director of the Regroupement pour une politique familiale, who took care of some technical aspects. The AGPQ will continue to improve its training program.

Presence throughout Quebec

Two AGPQ leaders attended a conference on grandparents' rights at the "Québec Barreau" Congress. The AGPQ was also present at the INRS Symposium on the revision of the Quebec adoption regime.

Several conferences were given in the regions to inform seniors about AGPQ services: Rivière-du-Loup, Trois-Rivières, Montréal, Québec, Beauport, Loretteville, Vanier, Victoriaville, Saint-Hubert, Longueuil, Saint-Augustin, Saint-Félicien, Saint-Damase en Montérégie and Val d'Or.

Media presence

The AGPQ's media presence was once again exceptional this year. Two broadcasts of interviews given by AGPQ leaders and grandmothers allowed him to make himself known. Me Luc Trudeau, lawyer and member of the Board of Directors gave an interview on the community television TVRM30 of the MRC Les Moulins et L'Assomption. Mrs. Monic Avoine, Mr. Henri Lafrance and two grandmothers, with custody of their grandchildren, gave interviews on TVA's J.E. show. These were released in January and May 2009. Ms. Ginette Paquette gave an interview to the daily Le Nouvelliste de Trois- Rivières.
